ORDER 1995**

DIRECTION MADE UNDER ARTICLE 4(1)

LAND AT JUNCTION OF LEYPARK ROAD AND HILL BARTON ROAD, EXETER

1. Exeter City Council ("the Council"), being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of article 4(6) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 ("the Order") is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the descriptions set out in the Schedule below should not be carried out on the land shown hatched black on the attached plan being land at the junction of Leypark Road and Hill Barton Road, Exeter ("the Land"), unless permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
2. The Council, using its power under article 4(1) of the Order hereby directs that the permission granted by article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development on the Land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule below.

SCHEDULE

Development by or on behalf of an electronic communications code operator for the purpose of the operator's electronic communications network, being development comprised within Class A Part 24 of Schedule 2 to the Order, but limited to the types of development described in paragraph A.2(4) of that Class (namely development subject to the prior notification procedure contained within Class A.3 of Part 24), and not being development comprised within any other Class.

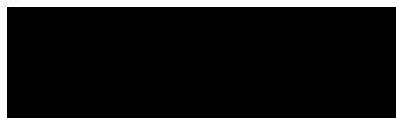

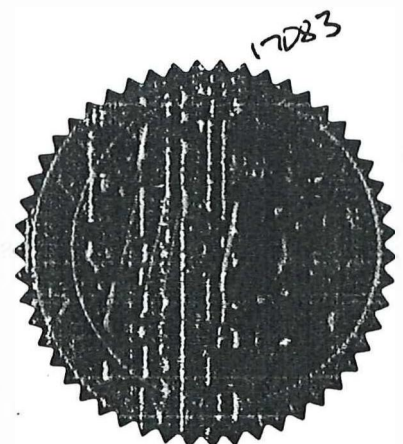
